

ENHANCING QUALITY

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan is a mission programme to provide quality Education to all children in 6-14 age groups. The Right to Education Act at Central level and the proposed J&K Right of Children to Free and compulsory Education Act to be soon introduced in Jammu and Kashmir are primarily aimed at achieving this aim of quality Education as per NCF-2005.

The State has embarked upon a massive teacher training programme for in-service teachers for their capacity building and enhancing their teaching skills so that the learning levels of students are up-graded. The Induction training for newly appointed teachers orients them to a child friendly environment.

Vision for Quality Improvement (Quality parameters) under SSA

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, J&K has formulated the following strategies to address quality concerns, besides provision of infrastructure and human resource for primary education:

- 1 Provision of improved curriculum.
- 2 Provision of teaching learning material.
- 3 Improving the quality of teaching learning process through the introduction of child centered pedagogy/ Active Pedagogy.
- 4 Change in classroom processes.
- 5 Increased focus on specification and measurement of learner achievement levels
- 6 Capacity building of teachers.
- 7 Onsite academic support to teachers.
- 8 Preparation of Supplementary material for teachers & Workbooks for students.
- 9 Learning enhancement initiatives
- 10 Tracking the performance indicators for Teachers & Trainers to improve the performance of teachers.

ACHIEVEMENTS

2012-13

- All upper Primary schools have been provided with library grant @ Rs 10 thousand per school.
- All Primary school have been provided with library grant @ Rs 3 thousand per school.
- Learning corners have been established in all Upper Primary school under LEAP

- Free supply of Textbooks: 382820 Children at primary level and 403526 children at upper primary have been provided free textbooks.
- 10966 teacher have received in-service teacher training out of the target of 38141 at Cluster level.
- Capacity building of 2000 Zonal Resource Persons (ZRPs)/ Cluster resource Persons (CRPs) have been done during the year 2012-13.
- Induction teacher training: 1565 teacher have been provided induction teacher training.

2013-14

- In-service teacher Training: 7124 teacher have received in-service teacher training out of the target of 67712 at zonal level.
- Training was given to 2000 ZRPs/CRPs.
- Free textbooks were provided to 786346 students of which 382820 belong to primary section and 403526 are from upper primary section.
- 2-sets of free uniform is provided to 1087678 children during 2013-14 @Rs 400 per child.
